Summer Camp Counsellors

The Pickering Rouge Canoe Club (PRCC) is looking for enthusiastic camp councillors **between the age of 16 and 30** for PRCC's Canoe and Kayak Camp. The Camp runs full days during July and August at Rouge Beach in Scarborough for children ages 6 to 13. A Leader-in-training (LIT) program is available for teens ages 14 to 16. Positions are full-time from June 29 to September 4, with training occurring in June.

Duties include:

- Responsibility for the health, safety and well-being of campers.
- Planning activities that help all campers experience success.
- Teaching boating skills and water safety.
- Preparing weekly lesson plans.
- Conducting regular camper head-counts, keeping accurate records, and filing incident reports when appropriate.
- Maintaining a positive relationship with campers, parents, and staff.
- Setting a good example for campers in all areas by showing respect, enthusiasm, cleanliness, punctuality, and good sportsmanship.

Requirements

- Current Standard First Aid/CPR (Level C)
- Clear Police Records Check, with Vulnerable Sector Check
- Canoe Kids certification (training available in May)
- Minimum of 16 years of age (17 for Lead Councillor)
- Experience working with children
- Experience in a camp setting is an asset
- Proven leadership, customer service and communication skills
- Canoe and kayak experience is an asset (required for on-water councillors)

Pay rate above minimum wage (higher pay depending on experience) for 30 to 40 hours per week.
