Sprint Coaches for Canoe and Kayak Summer Program

The Pickering Rouge Canoe Club (PRCC) is looking for responsible and enthusiastic Sprint Coaches **between the ages of 17 and 30** for our canoe and kayak summer programs which run full days at Rouge Beach in Scarborough. We are looking for both on-water and dryland coaches to work full-days from June 29 to end of August/early September with orientation training beforehand.

Duties include:

- Being responsible for the health, safety and well-being of children aged 9-14 participating in the summer sprint program.
- Planning activities that help everyone of all abilities experience success.
- Teaching paddling techniques, boating skills and water safety and leading dryland games and activities.
- Conducting regular head-counts, keeping accurate records and filing incident reports when appropriate.
- Maintaining positive relationships with paddlers, parents and staff.
- Setting a good example for paddlers in all areas, including respect, enthusiasm, cleanliness, punctuality and good sportsmanship.
- Assisting with loading and unloading the trailer before and after races.
- Being responsible for completing race entries for your group to submit to the Head Coach by assigned date.

Requirements

- Current Standard First Aid/CPR (Level C), Canoe Kids certification (training available on May 25), clear Police Records Check with Vulnerable Sector Check.
- Pleasure Craft Operator's Card.
- Experience working with children.
- Proven leadership, customer service and communication skills.
- Previous coaching experience and experience in a camp setting is an asset.

Pay rate is above minimum wage and based on skills and experience (higher pay with ELCC certification) for 30 to 40 hours per week.
